# The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the Secretary of the Interior has been deposited in the General Land Office, directing that a fee simple patent issue to the claimant Frank Glass, an Indian of the White Earth Reservation, for the Lot four and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section two in Township one hundred forty-four north of Range forty-one west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Minnesota, containing seventy-eight and thirty-seven-hundredths acres,

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever.
